Human Trafficking

What is Human Trafficking???

The recruitment, transportation, or harbouring of persons for purposes of exploitation, usually for sex trafficking, but can be labour trafficking as well.



Who is being trafficked??

Youth (average entry is 13)
93% in Canada are Canadian born
Easily influenced
Low Self esteem
No strong family and/or friend supports

Online
Shopping malls
Schools
Group Homes/shelters
On the street







Online Safety

- Keep computers/phones in open spaces (living room, family room, etc)
 - Monitor time spent online
 - Avoid giving out personal information
 - DO NOT send pictures or videos
 - DO NOT meet strangers in person

What are the signs someone is being trafficked?

Sudden interest in someone older New clothing, jewelry, gifts Sudden change in style Change in attitude towards school, regular activities, family/friends **Drop in grades** Missing school Having/using TWO cell phones New circle of friends Frequent sleepovers **Unexplained cuts and/or bruises**





What is Grooming??

- Process where predators work to gain the trust of the victim while doing their best to isolate them from family and friends.
- Made to believe they are in a relationship (boyfriend/girlfriend)
- Promises are made, such as they will be together forever
- Extravagant gifts are bought

Grooming • acts like a boyfriend • promises love • buys gifts

SEX TRAFFICKING: HOW IT HAPPENS

LURING

Establishing a connection, in person or online, with the intent of developing a relationship for the purpose of exploitation.



ISOLATION

Creating distance between the individual and their loved ones.



EXPLOITATION

Ensuring ongoing participation in commercial sexual acts while taking away their earnings.



GROOMING

Identifying and fulfilling the needs and dreams of the individual, for example by showering them with gifts.



MANIPULATION & COERCION

Sending mixed messages, making claims like 'you owe me' or making threats to cause the individual to feel their only option is to participate in commercial sex acts.
